We have excluded some trees from the city's approved list because they are not readily available in the nurseries.

<u>Class One</u>	<u>Class Two</u>
<u>Large Shade Trees</u> Ash, Texas Bald Cypress Elm, Cedar Oak, Bur Oak, Chinquapin Oak, Lacey Oak, Live Oak, Red (shumard, Texas) Pecan Persimmon, Texas	Buckthorn, Carolina Buckeye, Mexican Cherry-Laurel Crepe myrtle Peach Plum, Mexican Redbud, Texas Smoke Tree, American Sumac, Flameleaf
<u>Small Ornamental Trees/bushes</u> Eve's Necklace Holly, Possumhaw Holly, Yaupon Mountain Laurel	

75% of the trees planted must be from class one list and 25% can be from the class 2 list.

Trees must be a minimum of 3" caliper. For small, multi-trunked trees/bushes you may add the measurements of each trunk to arrive at a total caliper size.

Trees that are planted on construction sites using these guidelines will count toward mitigation for the City of Austin's tree protection ordinance.
